A copy of legislative bills currently being tracked that may be of interest to the Board was provided. LB 899, introduced by Senator Lonowski, will revise the Engineers and Architects Act. The main revision is to move the Principles and Practices of Engineering (PE) exam to direct registration, eliminating the need for Board approval to sit for the exam. Other housekeeping revisions are also being made.

Russell Moore, Edwards Westerhold Moore (EWM), legislative liaison, reported that the main focus of the session will be the budget deficit and property tax relief. There have been approximately 50 to 60 bills introduced by agencies and departments to cut programs, combine boards, commissions, and committees, and raise fees to help reduce the deficit.
