- For engineering applicants who are applying for licensure verification of good standing must be provided by the state of current licensure, including the discipline of examination. Should the state not license by discipline, or the discipline of your PE exam is not available, verification of discipline may be provided by submitting this form from one licensed professional engineers familiar with your experience.
- **Engineers applying for a Structural Engineering license cannot use this form.** To be eligible to be licensed as a Structural Engineer in Nebraska, you must have either passed sixteen hours of the NCEES structural engineering exams, or be licensed as a Structural Engineer in another state with 15 years or more of structural engineering work experience.

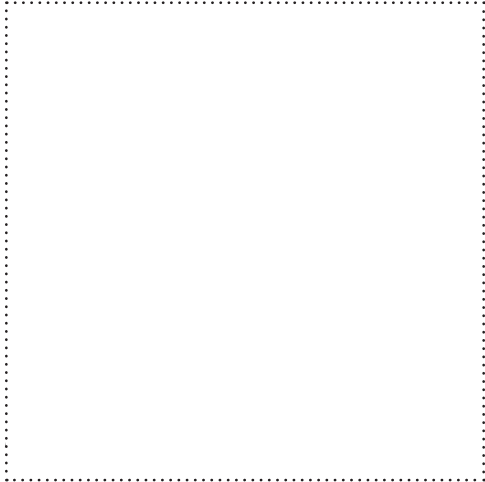
