

Nebraska Board of Engineers and Architects

The Board of Engineers and Architects held this hearing to consider revisions and receive public comment on proposed changes to Title 110, Nebraska Administrative Code, Rules and Regulations, Chapters 1-10 (Chapter 11 deleted and language moved to Rule 1.6.2).
